

Catering



Tracks

- Tracks are well groomed, hard model event provided accurate demonstration of the quality of the different tracks
- Very wide tracks < 3.0m 25%
 Wide tracks 1.6-3.0 m 15 %
 Narrow Tracks 1.2-1.6 m 60 %














Controls

- Two units at all controls, placed on both side of the track
- Control number on flags and units
- Back-up is the second unit of the control















Map Type

- Scale 1:5'000, 5m interval
- A4
- Maps will be collected after finish
- Maps will be returned after the race at the info desk













SIACs placement

- Both SIACs have to be placed at the same arm
- Sportident recommends to place SIACs on the opposite arm than competitors (own) GPS-watch
- Official GPS-device will be placed on competitors back













Maximum skiing times

- Sprint, 90 minutes
- Pursuit 3 hours
- Middle distance 3 hours
- Sprint relay, 3 hours














Stadium Layout















Quarantine

- Entry to quarantine area through main entrance "Bualino"
- Quarantine rooms are located in the basement of "Bualino"
- All team members will be registered at the entry to quarantine area
- Coaches are allowed to leave the quarantine through main entrance at any time but can't re-enter.
- Quarantine includes warm-up area (competitors are allowed to go back from warm-up to quarantine room)
- No coaches at start area (but they can stay in spectator or finish area)













Handover of Skis

- Ski racks labelled per nation
- Skis on both sides, please look at the label
- Waxmen deliver skis from one side
- Athletes take it from the other side















Start procedure

- Start procedure according to bulletin 4
- Start gate will be used
- Start clock shows competition time
 - background turns orange 9sec before zero
 - background turns green and beeps start 5sec before zero
- the competitor may start any time between five seconds before the start signal and the start signal. If a competitor starts late, the start list time is taken as the start time. A competitor who starts more than 5 seconds early will be disqualified.
- Distance time start to start point 100 m



Finish procedure

- According to the bulletin 4
- The time is registred when the SIACs cross the finish line
- Read out right after the finish
- Refreshment: Sponser sportsdrink, best mountain water;)
- After the finish competitors pick up their bag's from designated area and can leave the arena to waxing/changing facilities










Stadium Layout

- Pick-up after medal ceremony














Start procedure

- Two rows (one for even and one for odd numbers)
- Start clock shows number and name of the competitor and countdown

to start

- 5 sec before start seconds turn into purple
- at 0 sec it turns green
- Similar startclocks at the entry to the start area

1. loop map on top, 2. loop below






