- Spare equipment until 9.30 beside the waxing cabins














# Golf greens

#### Golf course track

 Marked as public snow mobile route on the map

- Half meter wider than narrow track
- 30-40cm high sharp snow walls
- Caterpillar tracks on each side
















# Golf course track entering green

# Narrow bridges

• There are several narrow bridges in the terrain















#### **Tracks**

Very wide tracks < 3.0m 30%</li>
 Wide tracks 1.6-3.0 m 20 %
 Narrow Tracks 1.2-1.6 m 50 %













### Start procedure

- Enter the arena through the tunnel
- GPS distribution at the end of the tunnel
- Enter start area 4min before to clear and check, 3min before lineup
- 8 starters in a row, 5 rows, doublepoling first 50m
- On command "maps" volunteers hand out maps 15sec before start
- 1st loop upside (loops are marked with 1 and 2 on the map)
- Start with gun shot
- Coaches are allowed to go until k-point with spare poles













### Map Type

- Scale 1:10'000, 5m interval
- A4, printed on both sides, athletes will need to flip the map at the end of first loop
- Women's maps will be collected after finish
- Maps will be returned after the race at the info desk














# Stadium Layout Middle















### Quarantine

- All athletes have to enter to quarantine area through main entrance "Bualino"
- Quarantine rooms are located in the basement of "Bualino"
- All team members will be registered at the entry to quarantine area
- Coaches are allowed to leave the quarantine through main entrance at any time but can't re-enter.
- Quarantine includes warm-up and start area (competitors are allowed to go back from warm-up to quarantine room)













### Finish procedure

- According to the bulletin 4
- The athlete in front approaching the finish can not change lane on the last 50m
- The time is registred when the SIACs cross the finish line . In case of photo finish the front of the ski boot is considered
- Read out right after the finish
- After the finish competitors pick up their bag's from designated area and can leave the arena to waxing/changing facilities

 Narrow Tracks 1.2-1.6 m 40 %














# Stadium Layout Sprint Relay
















### Change over area

### Start procedure

- Enter start area:4min before clear/check3min before line up
- Amount of starters per row will be communicated after entry deadline
- doublepoling first 50m
- On command "maps" volunteers hand out maps 15sec before start
- Start with gun shot
- Coaches are allowed to go until the road before k-point with spare poles

- o 2nd loop
- o 3rd loop
- o 4th loop
- o 5th loop
- o 6th loop
- Map wall on the right hand side of the track, team numbers in decreasing order (number one is last)













### Material transport

- Plan the material transport to your accommodation with your team attache until Monday 8am


